


# The Kind Ants

Happy Grasshopper









Gus the grasshopper lived

carefree.






He loved to sing, dance,

tomorrow.






Not far away, Anty and

determined.






They carried grains back

winter would come.






One day, Gus asked why they worked instead of singing, with a playful grin.






Anty kindly explained that

find.






Gus laughed, hopped

worried but determined.






As weeks passed, the weather changed; leaves turned brown, and cold winds blew.






Anty and Annie worked

chill.






One morning, Gus woke

words with regret.






With slow steps, Gus went

weak and hopeless.






Anty and Annie felt surprised but concerned when they opened the door.






Gus admitted his mistake,

embarrassment.






The ants looked at each other, feeling thoughtful, but chose kindness.






Annie smiled gently and invited Gus inside, filling him with relief and gratitude.






Inside, Gus rested and ate,

feeling focused and proud.






Working together made
