











Ella woke to warm

“Where did you come from, little key?” Ella whispered again. Just then, a shimmering turquoise trail appeared across her floor, glowing softly as if it wanted her to follow.








Ella thought for a moment,

forest path ahead.






As the sun turned golden

carefully.






As the flowers finished







Ella knelt beside the little worm and held up

filled the sky.


It was the perfect ending to a

forest brighter once again.









As the night grew darker, Ella held the golden key tightly in her hands. The little cloud glowed softly above them, and the owl's feather shimmered with warm light.






Ella took a deep breath and held her glowing key close to her heart. She remembered how she helped the little worm find his family, and her fear slowly melted away.

Standing tall, she whispered, “Starlight, shine bright!” The key burst into golden light, and sparkling stars filled the dark blue sky.






The golden light slowly faded, and the forest grew calm again. Just then, a swirling golden door shimmered in the clearing, glowing softly like a sunset.
